What information we collect

When you complete a registration form (online via LoveAdmin or via a paper form) we may collect the following information:

- Name inc title
- Contact information including postal address, email address and telephone number
- DOB
- Occupation
- Car Registration details

What we do with the information we collect

The details you provide via a paper form or via our cloud based membership portal (LoveAdmin) will be stored in accordance with all relevant GDPR legislation. It will be downloaded from time to time to the password protected office computers for use by HSC office staff. Relevant contact information will be shared with relevant committee members for the purposes of contacting volunteers who have agreed to offer assistance to the club or to provide answers to specific enquiries.

If appropriate, any details regarding Gift Aid will be used by the club book keeper to reclaim tax on donations made under this scheme.

Any email address you provide us with will be used by HSC to keep you informed about news and activities related to the section you have joined, and also about Horsham Sports Club news and events.
